  - G. Other mutually agreed educational programs.

**II. Definitions** – As used herein the terms “host organization” and “home organization” shall have the following meanings

A. Host organization – the organization accepting the faculty member/scientist or student.

B. Home organization – the organization providing the faculty member/scientist or student.

Period of Agreement – This MOU shall remain in force for three years from the date of the last signature. Prior to the expiration date, this agreement may be reviewed for possible renewal for a further three-year period. Either party may terminate this MOU by providing 60 days advance written notice to the other party.

**III.** In this case. Personnel already participating in the exchange shall serve out their terms under the conditions specified at the time of their appointment.

**IV. Activities Under This Agreement** – It is expected that activities taking place under this agreement will be initiated primarily in coordination with their respective administrative units concerned with such activities. ### **IX General:**

- Both the parties may receive information proprietary to other party (the "Confidential Information") in the course of performance of their obligations under this MOU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by the parties from third parties without accompanying secrecy obligations; (c) is already in either party's possession and was lawfully received from sources other than the parties or (d) is independently developed by the parties. The two bodies understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust, to be disclosed only to such persons as have a "need to know" the same for the effective implementation of this MOU and that it will only be used by the parties for the benefit of others.
- Both the parties understand and agrees that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other party in performing its obligations under this MOU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to other party and that other party will have all rights, title and interest therein.
- Both parties shall not use the name and brand of the other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.
- Any and all disputes or differences arising out of or in connection with this MoU or its performance shall, so far as it is possible, be settled by negotiations between the Parties amicably through consultation & understanding.

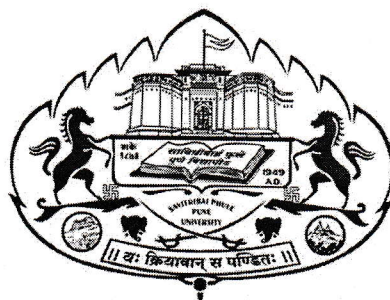

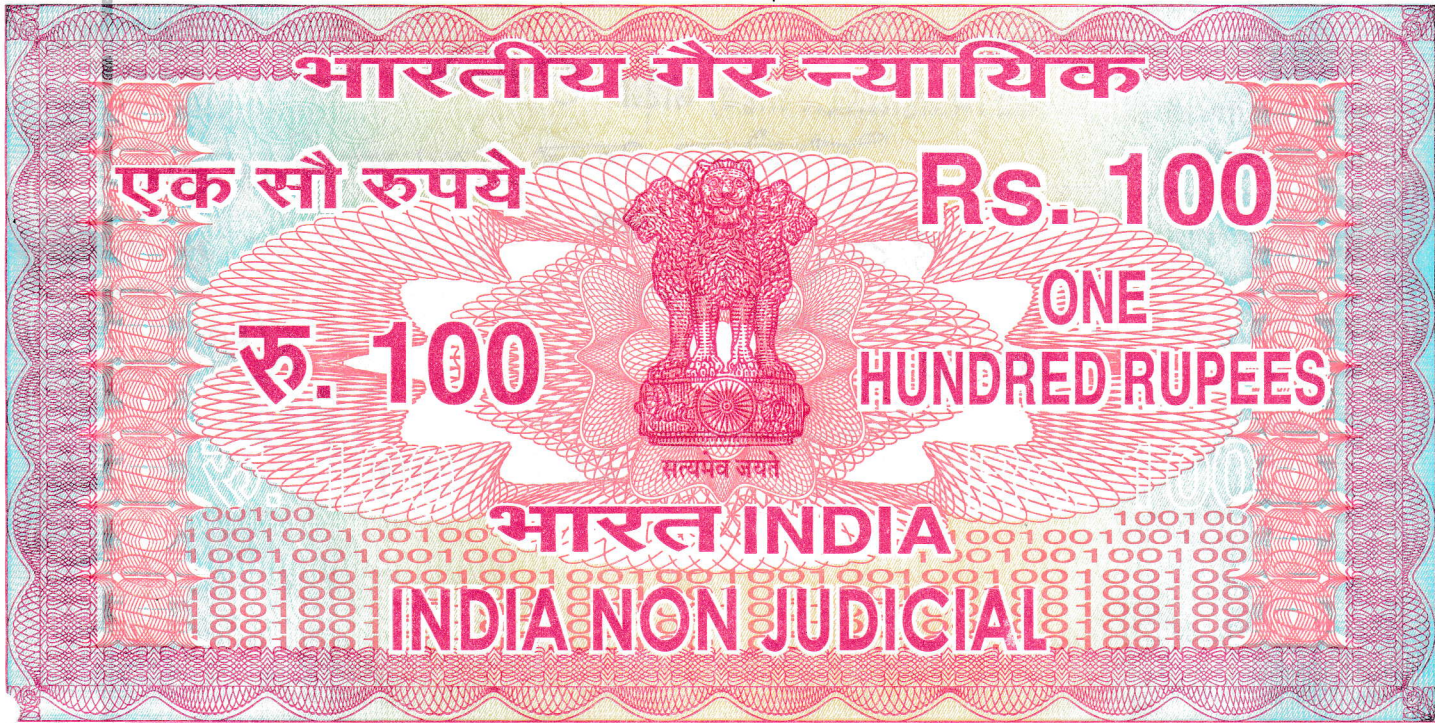

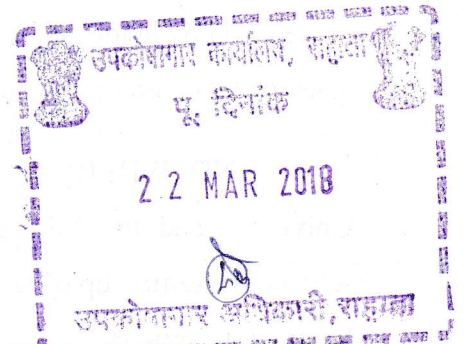

- ix) Achieve targets given in the Detailed Project Report (DPR)/ supplementaries to DPR/ Presentations made before PAB, mentioned in Annexure II of this MoU, which shall form an Integral part of this MoU;
- x) Comply with the terms and conditions for the release of the first and subsequent grants by the

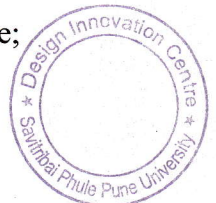

NRPL and PRCOP for enhancing, within the country, the availability of highly qualified manpower in the areas of analytical technologies without any prejudice to prevailing rules and regulations in NRPL and PRCOP without any disregard to any mechanism evolved and approved by both the Party. The areas of cooperation can be extended through mutual consent.

## **ARTICLE-II: SCOPE OF ACADEMIC INTERACTIONS**

Both NRPL and PRCOP shall encourage students / faculty through the following arrangements:

a) Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective institute, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;

b) Organization of joint conferences and seminars;

c) Practical training of PRCOP students at NRPL. Two Training Program under NRPL Viz

i) Practical Training program on fundamental of operation and analysis on LCMS, HPLC, GCMS, ICP-MS, a 4 day training program.

ii) Hands on training program on fundamental of Pharma analysis on HPLC, UV and Wet Lab, a 2 week program

iii) Payment Terms & Conditions.

- a) Cheque Or DD on the name of NRPL will be Accepted,
- b) 100% one-time fees should be given before sending batch.
- c) Cash will not be accepted.

iv) NRPL will provide transportation facility to students from Nimani Bus Stop, Nashik to NRPL Lab.

v) No other facility will be provided by NRPL.

vi) 5% concession will be given on fees.

vii) Fee structure may vary from course to course as enclosed in MOU.

PRCOP Student need to approach NRPL through PRCOP to avail the concession for the above courses. To avail training for all the other courses offered by NRPL, Student may directly contact NRPL on Individual basis or through PRCOP based on mutual consent.

d) i) The students will carry out part of their Ph.D. research work or M.Pharm project at PRCOP and NRPL depending on the nature of the work as per rules of the respective institute depending on facilities and requirements. The Financial Arrangement for each specific requirement will be decided on a case to case Basis.



ii) NRPL, as well as research scholars, may also be allowed to enroll for their Ph.D (Research) / Pharmacy Course at PRCOP, subject to availability of seats, research facilities and subject to their fulfilling eligibility criteria and all other academic regulations of PRCOP.

iii) There will be no restriction on the contents of the thesis and on publication of results of the thesis, subject to the condition that no Intellectual Property Rights can be secured for any part of the work which will be decided with mutual consent.

iv) If the outcome of a project related to Analytical development which involves matter of secrecy and concern with security of the State and the Country, the same will not be allowed for publication/printing in any form such as Electronically/verbal, etc. If the outcome of a project results into an intellectual property, for which rights can be secured, it will be decided on case to case basis. Similarly, sharing of expenditure in securing such rights and income accrued through royalty etc by the parties under the law will be decided on case to case basis after mutual consultation.

v) Neither of the supervisors will publish the work carried out under this MoU without knowledge of the other.

#### **ARTICLE-III: SHARING OF FACILITIES**

a) NRPL and PRCOP shall make provisions to share their respective important facilities in order to promote academic and research interaction in the areas of cooperation based on case to case basis with respect to mutual consent on financial aspects.

b) NRPL may allow PRCOP students for project based internships subject to availability of facility with reference to project topic, which will be purely on trainee basis without any monetary benefit to trainee.

- Both the parties understand and agrees that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other party in performing its obligations under this MOU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to other party and that other party will have all rights, title and interest therein.
- Both parties shall not use the name and brand of the other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.
- Any and all disputes or differences arising out of or in connection with this MoU or its performance shall, so far as it is possible, be settled by negotiations between the Parties amicably through consultation & understanding.

### X. Indemnification :

Both the parties shall indemnify and hold each other harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages,
